Writer Tells Another "Freshman" Feud Story

One warm September day in 1898 a Trinity college senior snore up to a young man in the old tin hat in the new Epworth hall, put his arm around him and proceeded to give him a short pep talk on the duties of freshmen towards their betters. The next day the senior found the "freshman" willing to him. It was William Preston Few, who had just been appointed professor of English.
